Shore Points Amateur Radio Club Minutes of the meeting held March 17, 2016 at the Brigantine Community Center

New Business: Gary Paul spoke with Bill Shwoer. SCARA is moving their 2 meter repeater from the tower at the Stillwater Building in Northfield to the Tony Canale Center in Egg Harbor Township. The Stillwater location and antenna have been offered to SPARC in exchange for a financial contribution to help defray the expense of SCARA having a 440 antenna installed on the tower at the Stillwater site. Dave motioned, Gary seconded and the motion passed that we should make this move. Dave motioned, Rick seconded and the motion passed that Gary should offer SCARA up to \$250.00 toward this endeavor.

Revision of Constitution & By-Laws: Motions were made and passed resulting in the following changes to Article 7, Sections 1 and 2 concerning the terms and elections of officers.

Section 1: Paragraph B will be altered to eliminate language that was present only for the sake of the 1992 elections. Paragraph C, limiting the office of president to two consecutive terms, will be eliminated. Paragraph D will be altered to reflect the elimination of Paragraph C. Paragraph F will be altered and expanded to allow members to hold an elected office and an appointed office simultaneously, but not more than one of each.

Section 2: Paragraph F will be eliminated allowing nominees to be elected officers in other amateur radio clubs.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30 PM. Immediately following the meeting a 50/50 drawing was held. Rick drew the winning ticket which was held by Dan Rollins and the club netted \$16.00.
